Nursery

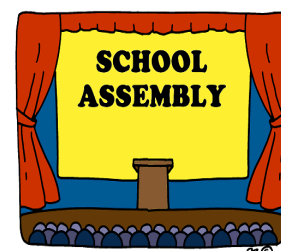
