CHANGES TO DATA PROTECTION LAW & OUR DATA PROTECTION PROCESSES

One of the biggest changes to UK data protection law comes into effect on 25th May 2018. The General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) becomes part of UK law, replacing and building on the 1998 Data Protection Act. This is a step towards you having more control over how your data and your child's data is used and how you are contacted. The changes will also better protect your personal data and are applicable to all organisations in the UK including schools.

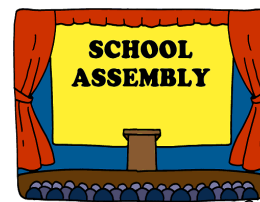
****Pooles Park Primary School takes its Data Protection responsibilities very seriously. To prepare for these changes we have:**
