Nursery

Year 4

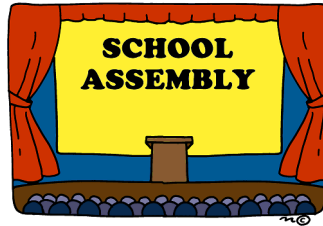
