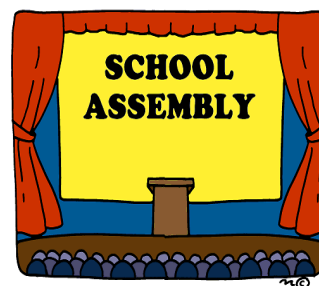
Year 5
