Nursery

We enjoyed "Green Eggs and Ham" this week. We made green eggs and had a little taste. We thought about what our favourite book was for World Book Day. Please read with your child every day and talk about the book in English or in your home language. Thank you!

Reception

We have read "Oliver's Vegetables" and have had great fun cutting up and examining various vegetables. We have discussed healthy eating and debated whether certain foods are healthy or unhealthy. We have explored weight, using balance pans and weighing scales, talking about how heavy and light different items are. We loved playing in the snow!

Year 1

Year 1 had an exciting week in the snow. We started looking at the book "The Gruffalo" for Book Week. We designed our own Gruffalo and wrote a descriptive piece about what he looks like! We enjoyed dressing up as our favourite book characters on Thursday for World Book Day. In Science, we had fun exploring in the garden, looking for Minibeasts, even though it was snowing.

Year 2

It has been a cold week in Year 2, but we have been keeping warm by working hard! We wrote our own fairy tales by changing the story of the Three Little Pigs to include our own characters and ideas. The children have completed reading assessments showing that they are making excellent progress. World Book Day showed how excited the children are about reading. Year 3

This week we have been working on "measure" in Maths, and thinking about the units of measurement for mass capacity, length and time. We have written and published our poems in Literacy, ready to perform next week. On Friday 9th March, Year 3 will be going on a Photography trip to Alexandra Palace. Please don't forget to bring in permission slips.

Year 4

This week Year 4 have really enjoyed starting to learn about William Shakespeare and his most famous play "Romeo and Juliet". They have been learning about the characters and have even learnt some famous lines from the play. In Maths, we have been working with decimals, and in Topic we explored music from around the world.

Year 5

This week started with a visit from the Fire Service. We hope all parents/carers were given their homework to make your home fire-safe! In Maths, we have been converting measurements, and in English we have been working on Shakespeare's The Tempest. We hope you had a happy World Book Day!

Year 6
