

#### Nursery

The children are gradually becoming more used to the structure of the day, rules and routines, and this week we have been focussing on "lining up". We met "Reno and Sammy" - the friendly puppets that help us to learn how to share and take turns. On Monday, we all visited the Forest Garden to say hello to the hens! We have also been enjoying lots of water play, both inside and outside, so please remember to leave a bag of clean clothes on your child's peg. Also, please come to our Curriculum Morning on Tuesday 9th October at 9.00 a.m., so that you can see how teaching and learning happens in Nursery.

#### Reception

We have enjoyed reading "Titch" this week and introduced "hot seating" with the children. This is a little dramatic activity where children pretend to be a story character and other children ask questions! Titch is a great introduction to talking about "size" - our word of the week - and we have done lots of comparison of height, as well as learning how to use balance scales to find heavier and lighter objects. The children enjoy singing and are very well behaved in Singing Assembly. Remember you can send a reusable water bottle in with your child.

#### Year 1

The Year 1 children are all becoming Maths geniuses! We have all been working hard in our Maths and Guided Maths sessions to compare numbers up to ten. Next week, we will start to look at our local environment as part of our Geography unit, in preparation for our upcoming treat to Finsbury Park.

We have had another exciting week watching how the chicks are growing and changing. We completed our final observations of them and used these to write a recount of the chick's stay in Year 2. Our trip to Kidzania is on Friday 12th October, please bring back your permission slips if you haven't done so already.

#### Year 3

This week we have started a new Literacy topic about non-fiction travel guides, learning to use headings, sub-headings and other organisational features. We are very excited to be going on our first Year 3 trip next Friday (12th) to Victoria & Albert Museum of Childhood. Please return the permission slip and money as soon as possible.

#### Year 4

This week, Year 4 have been learning about stories with a dilemma in Literacy. We started our learning by exploring what the word "dilemma" means and thinking about difficult choices we have had to make. In Maths, we are continuing to embed our knowledge of place value - this week we have been identifying the value of digits in 4 digit numbers. Both classes have been preparing for their upcoming Assemblies, please help your child to learn their lines at home.

#### Year 5

Year 5 have had a great week extending their knowledge of number with word problems. Stratford Class have begun to debate the importance of Shakespeare in School, and Liverpool Street have been looking at historical texts, such as Beowolf! We are all looking forward to starting next week with a trip to the National Gallery to look at stories through Art.

#### Year 6

Hoxton Class have had a very exciting week at IntoUniversity. We have enjoyed extending our knowledge about World War 2 and had a fantastic trip to HMS Belfast on Wednesday and an exciting graduation at Cambridge University on Friday.
