Just a couple of weeks to go before the Summer Holidays, with lots of hard work and fun activities to bring us towards the end of Year 3!

#### Year 4

Year 4 have had a busy week learning about statistics in Maths so that they can collect their own data and make bar charts. In Literacy, they have been planning a court case for Rumpelstiltskin and in Topic, they have been learning about the boy king Tutankhamun. They also enjoyed a workshop planting seeds in the garden, followed by our Garden Festival on Friday.

#### Year 5

The children have worked very hard this week on multiplying and dividing by powers of 10, and answering word problems using this skill. In English, we have started a new writing project – writing a Science Fiction story. In Music, we have continued to listen to and reflect on Gustav Holst’s “The Planet Suite”. 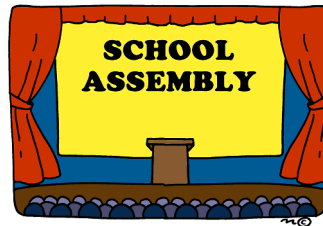
#### Year 6
